## Faith in Action

The Eucharistic celebration (Mass) encompasses all forms and expressions of prayer, and through it, we express, celebrate, and profess our faith. The readings, the songs, and the prayers of the Mass all come together to enrich and strengthen our faith. Within the Mass, we respond, "We proclaim your death, O Lord, and profess your resurrection until you come again" In this, we express our faith in the mystery of the past, the mystery of the present, and the mystery of the future. Faith, as God's given gift, is meant to be shared, and when it is shared, it multiplies.

The readings of today, in different ways, call us to reflect on this faith, God's given gift, which helps us to serve and trust Him. Our second reading this Sunday, the letter to the Hebrews, describes the enduring examples of the faith of Abraham (the father of our faith) and the power of faith, which is an affirmation of what the book of Wisdom in the first reading says about the patriarchs, "they put their faith" in God. The gospel reminds us that the act of faith is not only in beliefs but also in action by "Knowing and doing the master's will."

Every true faith must be living, conscious, and active. Faith shows itself in action. At the end of every Mass, we are commissioned to "Go," an invitation to go and live out the faith we have, expressed, professed, and celebrated. We are called to reflect and ask ourselves, what are the ways God calls us to put our faith in action? These words of St. James are a great invitation to all of us: "So also faith of itself, if it does not have works, is dead. Indeed, someone may say, 'You have faith, and I have works.' Demonstrate your faith to me without works, and I will demonstrate my faith to you from my works" (James 2:17-18).

**FAITH**

Our readings today explore how faith begins and how faith works. Faith begins with God's initiative of love, together with God's promise about the future. The passage from Hebrews urges readers to have an assured confidence in God, who promised and delivered a lasting legacy to Abraham. The book of Wisdom reminds readers of the God who promised and delivered freedom from slavery during the Exodus. In the Gospel passage from Luke, Jesus begins with the promise that "your Father is pleased to give you the Kingdom," before describing how to live faithfully during times when God seems absent. God's promises mean that God is fully invested in our future. Living in these promises, we can confidently let go of fear and insecurity. We can anticipate that when God intervenes in our lives, it will be for our benefit. And we can become God's partners in fulfilling these divine promises.

**St. Frances Cabrini (1850-1917)**

**Feast Day: November 13th**

Did you know that Mother Cabrini was born two months early, she was small and weak as a child and remained in delicate health throughout her life but she lived 67 years and founded 67 institutions: schools, hospitals, and orphanages?



Though her health was always precarious, she relentlessly worked to minister to the needs she saw around her. In the late 1800's, Italians were greatly discriminated against in the United States. In the Catholic community they were often excluded and forced to worship in church basements. Few Italian priests or religious were available, and many Italian immigrants lost their faith. Mother Cabrini and her sisters went to where people were, speaking their language, bringing their culture, and reminding people that God was still with them in their new land.

Some of her lesser-known missionary work included going into dangerous mine shafts in Colorado to pray with Italian miners isolated from their families and praying with prison inmates immediately before their execution. Mother Cabrini teaches us that we can become holy in the ordinary circumstances in which we live our lives by responding to the concrete needs we see around us. St. Frances Cabrini- Pray for us!



### To be a catechist, mentor, and youth leader, you must:

- ◊ Have received the Sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation, and Eucharist.
- ◊ Complete the proper background screening, clear the criminal history check before engaging in ministry, and complete the appropriate Diocesan Safe Environment Training.
- ◊ Intend to complete the Introduction to Catechetical Ministry course offered by the Diocese of San Jose (for catechists and mentors).
- ◊ Be available for 1.5 hours weekly commitment (Wednesday evening or Sunday after youth Mass). Catechetical Formation and Youth Ministry programs will start in September 2022.

### Catechetical Formation Registration Starts August 14, 2022

We open registration for ongoing Formation year-round (1st to 12th grade).

To receive First Eucharist, your child must attend a 2-year program. If your child is in 1st grade, this is a good time to enroll them!

**To receive Sacraments (First Eucharist or Confirmation) in 2023, registration to Sacramental Preparation Program must be done no later than November 1, 2022.**

### Stewardship

In practicing stewardship, we are called to do God's work, to be a steward of the many gifts He has given us. Everything is a gift from God that we should receive gratefully, cherish, and tend responsibly, share with others and return to God with increase. We encourage all to become stewards of His gifts to us. We thank all those who are generous with their gifts of time, talent, and treasure for the growth of our St. Frances Cabrini Parish community and school.



In a random sample of 6,000 households receiving free groceries during the pandemic at Second Harvest's distributions in Santa Clara and San Mateo counties, respondents revealed the depth of impact the economic downturn has had on low-income households and that the financial implications of the crisis are far from over:

50% of the respondents indicated that they have had to delay paying their rent or mortgage during the pandemic. 57% of survey respondents reported they have less than \$100 in savings right now.

More than 70% of respondents indicated that someone in their household had lost a job and/or experienced a reduction in their work hours since shelter-in place started in March 2020.

Of those who have remained employed, 70% identified as essential workers, which means they've been working outside the home in health care, food service, janitorial and retail jobs to support our community's access to basic needs.

The above statistics taken from a Second Harvest Of Silicon Valley survey in 2021, speak to issues that still persist in our own parish and its surrounding communities. If we can do one thing, right now, it is to make sure that we are able to provide food twice a month to those in need and we keep our SFC Food Pantry shelves stocked with non-perishables and toiletries.
