

The Mercy of God: Infinite and Definite!

On October 22nd, we celebrated as a Church, the feast of Pope St. John Paul II. We remember this great Pope for his service to the Church, especially during his 27 years as a Pope. Also, we remember him as the Pilgrim Pope who traveled to 129 countries to encounter people and share God's love and mercy with them. In 1980, Pope John Paul II wrote an Encyclical, *Dives in Misericordia (DM)* - (God, who is rich in mercy), in which he reflected on the richness of God's mercy and the mission of Jesus to share this mercy with us. He stated, "Christ confers on the whole of the Old Testament tradition about God's mercy a definitive meaning. Not only does He speak of it and explain it by using comparisons and parables, but above all, He Himself makes it incarnate and personifies it." (DM, #2).

One of the central themes the readings of this Sunday reflect on this invitation Pope John Paul gave us to share in the richness of God's mercy, which is infinite and definite. Our first reading, the book of Wisdom (Wisdom 11:22 -12:2), reminds us of God's mercy, "But you have mercy on all because you can do all things, and you overlook people's sins that they may repent." Likewise, one of the lines of our Responsorial from Psalm 145 reminds us, "The Lord is gracious and merciful, slow to anger and of great kindness." Similarly, the richness of God's mercy is well depicted in the Gospel of Luke (19:1-10) through the story of Jesus' encounter with Zacchaeus, the Tax Collector.

We have so much to learn from the gospel story: First, Zacchaeus's desire to experience God's mercy. Thus, he strove to encounter Jesus. Second, Zacchaeus' determination to overcome all obstacles to experience the Mercy of God. Jesus recognized his efforts, encountered him, and allowed him to experience the richness of God's mercy in its fullness. Jesus, in this encounter, reminds us of his primary mission, "For the Son of Man has come to seek and to save what was lost." Like Zacchaeus, we all need the mercy of God to different degrees. Let us ask God for the strength to overcome the obstacles that hinder us from receiving this mercy, whether these obstacles come from our pride that makes us be in denial of our weaknesses and sinfulness or our despair that makes to give up in making efforts to receive the mercy of God and change our ways and behavior. Amen.

A COMPASSIONATE GOD

Today’s reading from the book of Wisdom presents an image of a patient God who “rebuke[s] offenders little by little” (Wisdom 12:2), an image endorsed by the psalmist, singing of how the LORD is “slow to anger and of great kindness, and compassionate toward all his works” (Psalm 145:8, 9). The crowd with Jesus, however, grumbles when they see Jesus’s kindness and compassion extended to Zacchaeus, who was not just a tax collector, but the “chief tax collector”—a title that surely emphasizes his standing as a sinner to be scorned. In the second reading, Saint Paul urges the Thessalonians to be “worthy” of God’s calling, so that “the name of our Lord Jesus may be glorified in you” (2 Thessalonians 1:12); such people, unlike the crowd in the Gospel, would rejoice at Zacchaeus’s determination to change his life after encountering Jesus.

Pardon Our Dust

The SFC Building Committee has a few projects underway. The week of October 24th will see the Woodard Rd. side of the Church under construction. Drive slowly and watch your step as you walk through the church parking lot. Construction will begin on the Woodard Rd. side of the church walkway. As the construction of an outside entry door at the new location of the Adoration Chapel (once the churches library) is going on, we must bring our walkway up to code. The Woodard Rd. side exit doors will be closed for construction and the walkway cordoned off. You'll need to exit from the Camden side of the church on the weekends until "caution" tape is removed.

This project will take approximately 4 weeks to complete. Don't forget, there will be construction noise from heavy equipment during business hours. Please be aware of your surroundings while on the property and let's keep everyone safe. Our crews are working diligently as possible to get this project completed. In the next few weeks, we will also start construction on the inside of the church. The removal of old and installation of new confessionals will be taking place. Your patience is appreciated as we create a safer place for all.

SFC's Annual Holiday Food Drive

The St. Frances Cabrini Men's Club will again be sponsoring the Annual Holiday Food Drive. Each year presents unique challenges. This year, we expect more requests for assistance due to the state of the economy and escalating food costs.

These events have a history dating back to the 1960s and have presented opportunities for the SFC community to demonstrate our compassion and care for the marginalized and less fortunate in our Cambrian Park area as well as throughout the Diocese.
